Information on Sex Offender Registration

Oregon law regarding sex offenders was passed to assist law enforcement in identifying offenders and preventing offenders from committing future crimes. The law requires that:

- After being convicted of certain sexual offenses, an offender is required to register in the state of Oregon
- This a lifetime registration
- If an offender moves to Oregon from out of state, s/he is required to register within 10 days
- An offender is required to report any changes of address
- Unless a change of address is reported, an offender is required to register once annually, within 10 days before or after his/her birthday
